



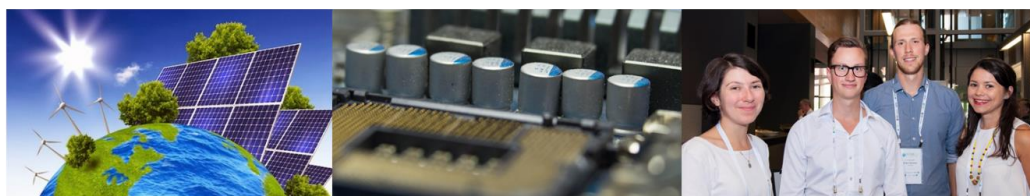

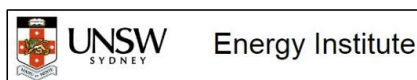

Conference Venue

The Energy Future conference 2020 will take place once again at the Colombo House, University of New South Wales, Sydney. Colombo House is the newest venue at the UNSW. Flowing with natural light, the Colombo House Theatres is the perfect space for conferences and exhibitions. With access from High Street, the venue includes 3 tiered lecture theatres, 2 combine-able flat floor spaces, foyer spaces and a pleasant courtyard.

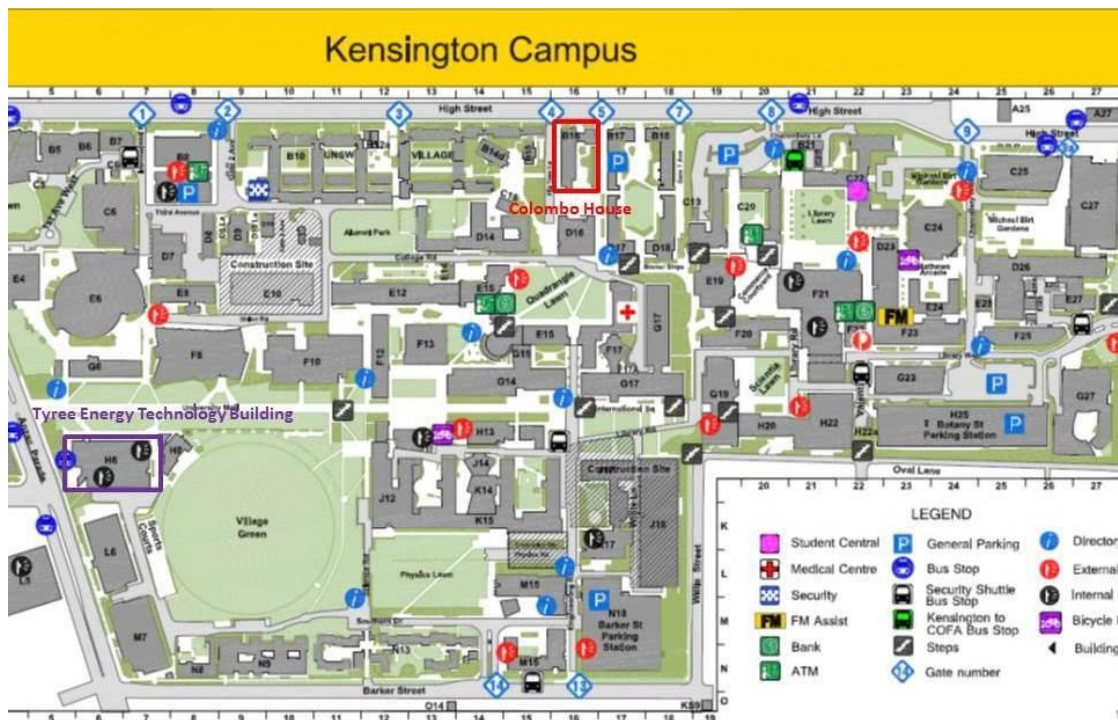
The conference program may also include a technical tour to some of the major Energy research facilities within UNSW, such as the Tyree Energy Technology Building (TETB) and UNSW Solar Industrial Research Facility (SIRF). TETB is the home of energy research at UNSW Sydney and the location of the UNSW Energy Institute. This landmark, 6-Star energy-efficient building is a state-of-the-art powerhouse of world-leading research, education and industry collaboration in the development and practical implementation of sustainable energy technologies. The TETB's laboratories support the ongoing research of UNSW researchers in world record-breaking solar photovoltaic technologies, sustainable clean fuels, smart grids, energy storage, energy economics and policy analysis. The TETB is also an educational hub for undergraduate and postgraduate students, providing an optimal learning environment for the expert engineers and analysts who will shape our energy future. Our Solar Industrial Research Facility (SIRF) is a showcase facility for solar cell research and development, and a key educational asset for training the future leaders of the photovoltaics industry.

This world-class, \$16 million turnkey pilot line manufacturing facility enables the development of UNSW's silicon solar cell technologies from laboratory processes to factory-ready industrial processes. It is the first facility of its kind in Australia.

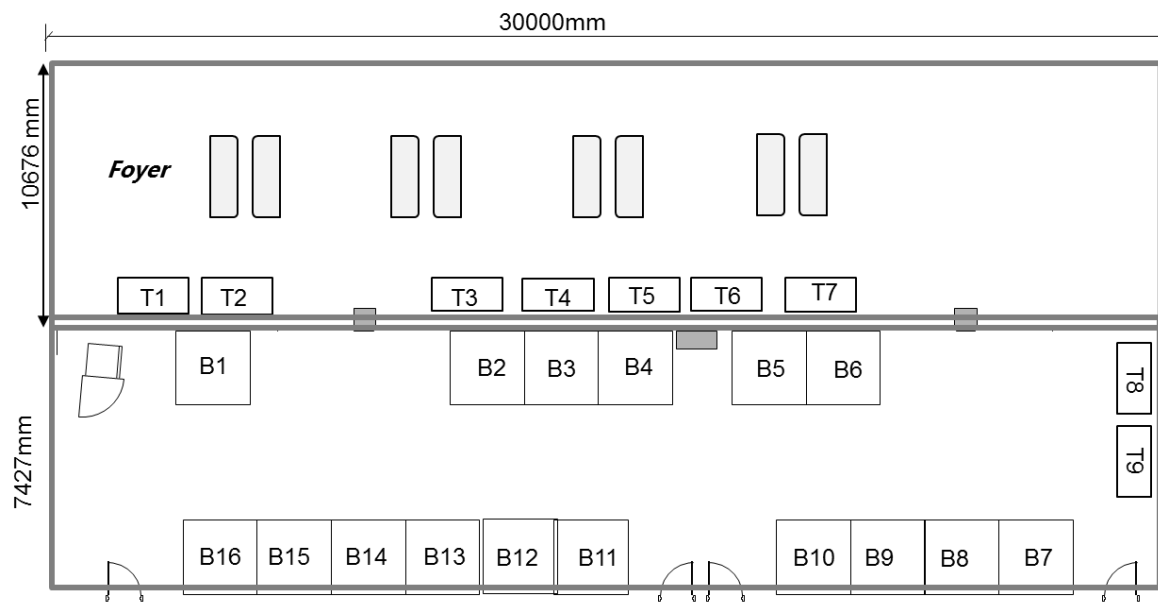

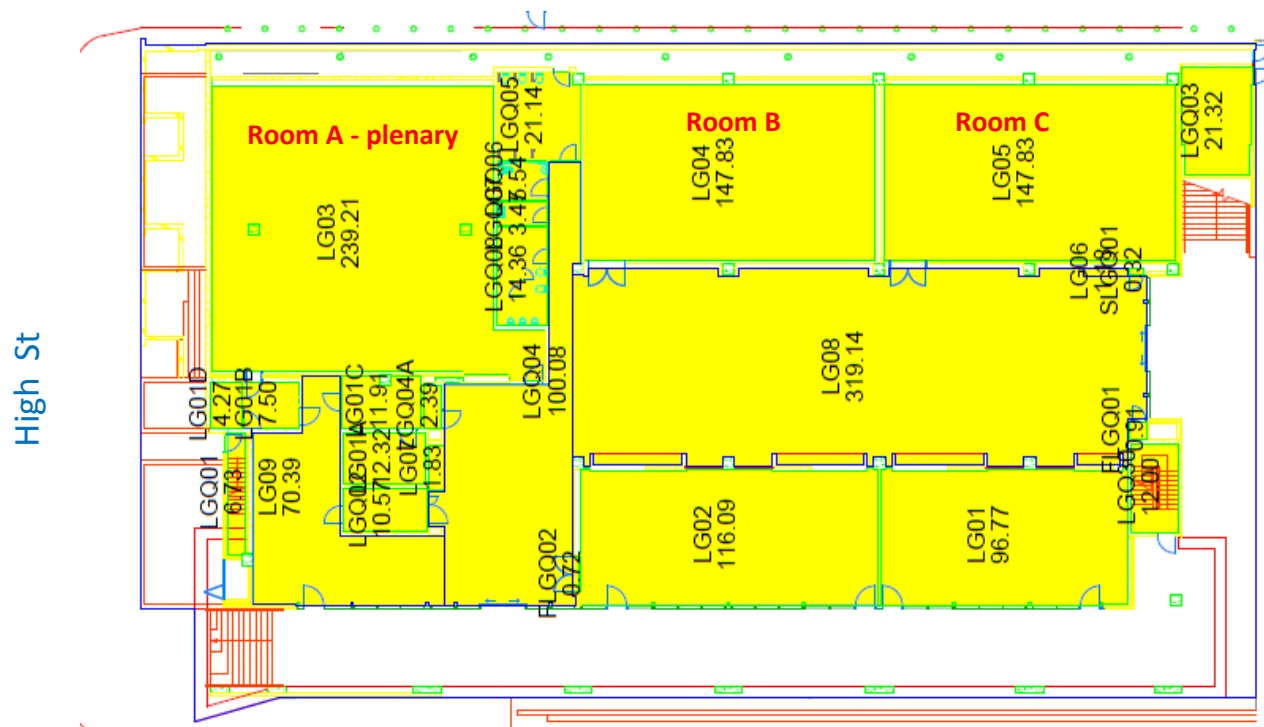

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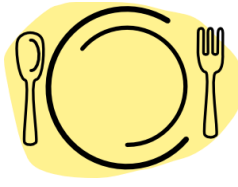

Cancellation Policy

If you would like to request the cancellation of your sponsorship application, please submit a written request for cancellation specifying the reason for cancellation. The cancellation request is subject to the approval of the committee on the condition that none of the sponsorship arrangements have been delivered upon and can be resold.

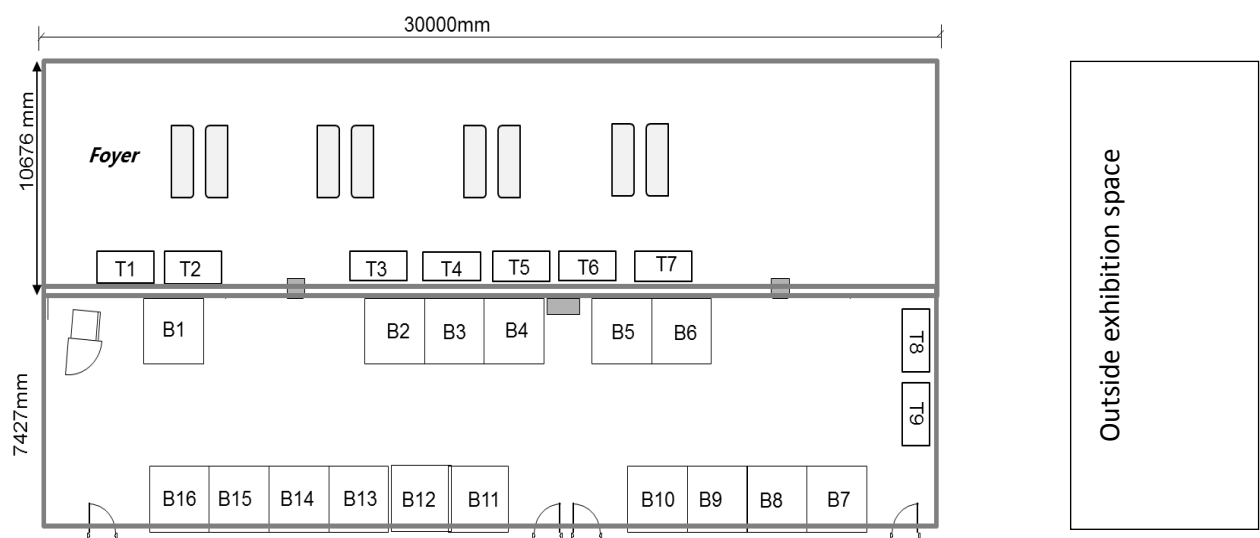

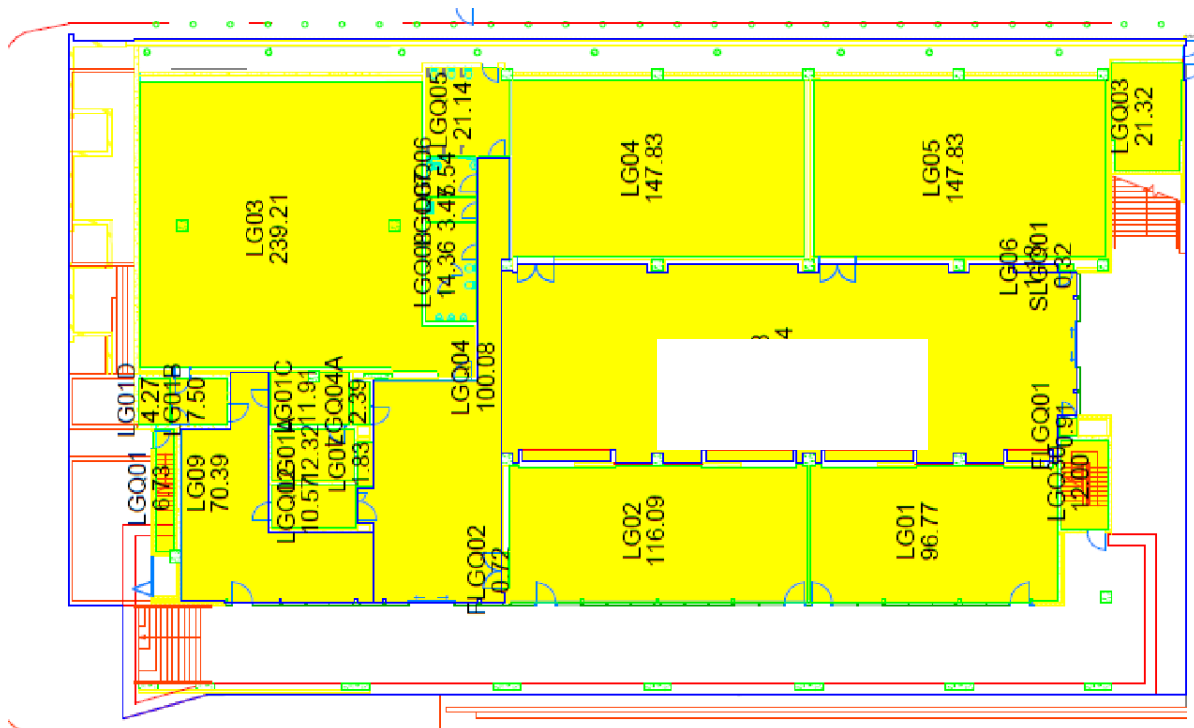

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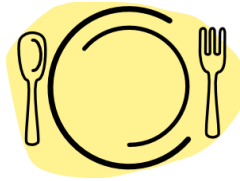
